



St. Andrew's C of E Aided Primary School Inter House & Erasmus+ SHAPE Multiplier Sports Event 2015

Wednesday 21st May

Context

'Inter-House' sports days in addition to our conventional Summer Term Sports Day. 'Inter-House' sports days split into 2 half-days - KS1, KS2. The children are allocated a house when they join the school and stay in that house until they leave. We attempt to keep an even distribution of genders, abilities and ages in the houses.

Example: KS2 Inter-house Sports

When broken down into houses there are 20-30 children in each house. ALL children run cross-country (split into a boy's race and a girl's race) and ALL children participate in 1 team sport of Hockey, Football or Netball. KS1 play modified versions of rounder (kicking a football instead of hitting) and netball (large football goals instead of hoops). A mini tournament is played for each team sport, with each house playing every other (6 games in total). The results are recorded to find a winner for each sport and an overall winner.

Rules

- Matches in all sports to be one period of 12 minutes in duration.
- All teams are seven a side, any number of substitutions can be made at any time.
- If a team has less than seven players they can borrow a player from another team.
- If possible a minimum of 3 boys and 3 girls should be on the pitch at all times.
- The referees of each sport will collect and record the results.

Netball

- (1) No running with the ball.
- (2) No contact between players
- (3) When you are marking a player your arms must be kept by your side. You can only raise your arms to intercept a moving ball.

Football

- (1) Normal football rules but no off sides
- (2) 1 nominated goalkeeper - must roll the ball out. Retake if not
- (3) Goalkeeper can be changed during a match.
- (4) Ball to be rolled in underarm - retake to other side if not.

Hockey

- (1) Normal hockey rules
- (2) A goal is scored when the ball is successfully hit into the opponent's goal from within the D.
- (3) The ball must be passed or dribbled using the stick and no other body part is allowed to intentionally come into contact with the ball.
